After that, there was the commitment of a single family, and over time, there was a team of passionate enthusiasts. After the organization was founded, the activity was built primarily on a volunteer basis. In recent years, we have suceeded in building an increasingly profesional team and we are getting better at what we do.

- ► Established on: November 2, 2010
- ► Main activity: Leisure and educational activities intended mainly for children and youth coming from the Roma community and living in socially excluded localities based on Christian values. Apart from activities for children, we also offer educational and leisure activities for whole families.
- ► **Motto:** "Helping kids be kids, so they can grow up to be better adults!"
- **▶ Origin of the name**: "Aneighbour close by is better than a family far away." - Proverbs 27:10, The Bible

- ► **Location:** Pilsen (Czechia) and nearby towns (Nýřany, Chotěšov, Stod, Merklín...)
- ► **Activities:** hobbies clubs, tutoring, workshops, project days, trips to nature, cultural events, sports and educational events, summer camps and summer holiday program, trips for families, educational seminars and other seminars.
- ► Scope of activity: 300+ people per year, 200+ children, 20+ volunteers, 50+ events per year
- ▶ Involvement in projects: "Neighbour Day", 72 Hours, Free Time Festival, Lively Street, Pilsen Courtyards

- 2018 trips for families with children, first two projects from the European Social Fund
- 2020 new premises in the Komenda building rented from the City of Pilsen
- 2022 first project from Norway Grants: "Family Teaching Family"
- 2023 three more projects granted by the European Social Fund
